

To limit warming to 1.5°C, scientists say we must cut emissions faster AND remove excess CO<sub>2</sub> already in the air.

We probably need to remove hundreds of gigatonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> by 2100. (Right now, we emit around 40Gt a year.) This is a massive challenge. The slower we cut emissions, the more we have to remove.

There are nature-based and tech-based approaches.

None are risk-free,
none are ready at scale,
and all need governance.

There are some international guidelines to address this, but not enough.

Policy makers need to fill the governance gaps.

Governments, businesses and civil society need to come together in a global joint effort to make this happen.
